## WA Legislative Update

 Update on the Building and Construction Industry Security of Payment Bill 2020 (the "WA Bill").



 Bill will introduce industry wide laws to enhance payment protections for subcontractors in line with the Government's election commitments.

## **Objectives of the Bill**

- Bill will introduce reforms in **four areas**:
  - New security of payment laws that are more consistent with the 'East Coast' model.
  - A retention trust scheme.
  - Enhancing the powers of the Regulator.
  - Fairer contracting practices.

## **Current status**

- Bill passed the lower house on 10 November 2020.
- Introduced into the upper house on 11 November 2020, but lapsed after the end of the 2020 Parliamentary sitting year.



- Government re-elected following the WA State General Election on Saturday 13 March 2021.
- Approval to be sought to re-introduce the Bill into Parliament.
